

Two weeks ago, we, your **Parish Pastoral Council**, reported about St. Timothy's first Celebration of Gifts and Talents (CGT) held on April 28<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Many people took the time to give feedback that will contribute to how to continue to move forward as a welcoming parish.

**This week we'd like to share with you answers to other questions asked on the questionnaire:**

- What would you like to have more of or see started?
- Is there a specific goal we should work towards as a parish?

**While these may seem like simple questions, we received some invaluable answers such as:**

- Continue faith development and engagement of our youth in addition to the strong catechism program we have for our children.
- On-going adult faith and spiritual growth.
- Reaching out to those in need in the community.

**Some ideas to respond to the feedback we received are:**

- Use of technology to engage our youth on pertinent issues. This would encourage our young people to remain part of and involved in the church.
- Create opportunities for continuous adult faith and spiritual learning and growth for all including married, unmarried, and families. Ideas offered include young families volunteering together and children's mass.
- Reaching out to those in need – the Society of St. Vincent de Paul (SSVP) of St. Timothy is a group of very committed individuals who continue to be the “face of Christ” to those in need. Other opportunities could involve: visiting the sick, elderly, or those in prison. Another could be starting a ministry to do with climate change - something that youth generally feel quite strongly about.

**One key element underpinning the feedback we received is the need to be able to REACH OUT to YOU to help us SPREAD THE GOOD NEWS to ALL!**
