

A Message from Fr. Brian

Greetings dear family,

Perhaps you heard the news from last night about the tightening of restrictions by provincial health. In the businesses and/or activities no longer permitted, faith based religious gatherings are listed. These restrictions are effective as of 12:01am this Sunday until May 30th. We are still unsure the details and what this all encompasses, but we can be sure that Masses and public gatherings for prayer are not possible for these 3 weeks.

We hope to find out if having a small team of liturgical ministers for the purposes of live streaming is even still possible, whether individuals can meet with me for sacraments, and whether our parish office can still remain open for drop off or pick up. These sorts of clarifications should come next week, so you can expect an update from us on these things.

For this weekend's Masses, we will be live streaming and recording our 4pm Mass as usual, which is actually a bit more of a special Mass for the Tri-Diocesan Family Life conference conclusion with our bishop presiding. We will not live stream this Sunday since we are still unsure on things, so we will have the link available in the usual spots (website, Facebook) for all to watch the Saturday 4pm Mass instead. Or click [here](#) for the link. It's the same link as the Conference so you may have to fast forward through the beginning part of the video to find where Mass begins.

Once I know what is permitted by the province and Archdiocese, I will certainly begin live streaming our usual Mass times so you can continue to be nourished spiritually through virtual means.

Thank you for your continued patience and care for one another. I will continually keep you all in my prayers during the Masses and in my praying of the breviary.
